

STAC'D Method

Primary Source Video Analysis

SEE	What do you see in the video? Do not talk about what it means or how it makes you feel, just describe exactly what you see. What events take place? Where do they take place? Who is in the video?
TELL	Thinking about what you saw in the video, what did the video tell you? How did it make you feel? Were there things that you saw that made you think of or reminded you of something else? Were there things that were not said in the video but you knew were happening?
AUDIENCE	When the video was filmed, who do you think it was made for? Who do you think saw the video? Was the video made for a specific group of people?
CLUES	What events or actions did you see in the video that helped you decide what it was telling you? What things did you see in the video that helped you decide w who it was made for?
DECIDE	What did you decide about the video? Why do you think it was made? Who was it made for? Is the video an example of a good source or a bad source? Use this section to describe your overall thoughts about the video.
