

Embedding a Video

To include one of TAMI's videos into another webpage, for example a blog or news article, you must obtain the code for our embeddable video player. To do this:

1. Click the Share button under the video player
2. From the drop down button, click Embed
3. Copy the code from the box to the right, and paste it into your own page.
